This workshop will explain how conservation easements work, and the potential benefits to landowners from enrolling in a conservation easement. Landowners who prefer to keep their land in agricultural production may be interested in enrolling in conservation easements. Conservation easements allow landowners to protect the agricultural and/or conservation uses of their property into the future. Easements can also be used by landowners to reduce the amount of estate or inheritance tax that their heirs must pay. They are voluntary agreements that keep land as rangeland, agricultural land, open space or natural habitat.
